A Scavenger Hunt for Information About Upper Arlington!

When does UA Quest happen?

The 2024 UA Quest will take place between Saturday, Mar 2 @ noon and Sunday, Mar 10 @ 7pm.

Is there an entry fee?

There is no cost to participate, but all teams must register. See uahistory.org/uaquest for information.

Who can participate?

This is an ALL AGES event for teams of six or less -- ideal for families or friends. New to UA or have younger kids? We have multiple levels of questions so everyone can enjoy and learn. Participants may be required to complete various tasks associated with each clue. However, people of all abilities should be able to find answers to several clues. Best of all, you don't have to complete it all to turn in an answer sheet and be eligible for prizes.

We encourage newer residents to sign up and play, too. UA Quest is part of the UA Welcome Series, stewarded by the Community Relations Committee, and there is a special prize just for newer residents (moved into UA in 2023 or 2024).

How do I play?

Step 1: Gather your team. This is designed for families and friends; teams need to include at least one adult as the Team Lead. Maximum team size is six members.

Step 2: Register at uahistory.org/uaquest by Friday, March 1 @ noon to receive the clues around the start of the event. All teams must register in order to receive the clues; teams registering after the deadline may wait up to 24 hours before receiving the set of clues.

Step 3: Upon receipt of the clues, follow the instructions and complete as much of the Quest as you want to / can.

Step 4: Send your responses by 7pm on Sunday, March 10 either:

(a) using the Google form link provided with the clues AND emailing info@uahistory.org with your team photos (*preferred*), or

(b) emailing a scanned copy of the paper form provided with the clues and your team photos to info@uahistory.org.



One email will be accepted from each team and must be sent before the deadline. (*Exception: If your photo sizes are too large to send in one email, you may send multiple emails but all at one setting.*)

What are the boundaries of UA Quest?

All clue answers can be found within the borders of the City of Upper Arlington.

What resources can we use to solve the clues?

Clues will require different skills to complete. Teams may use the internet, signage throughout UA, GPS, maps or other resources to search for information.

Do we have to solve all the clues to participate?

No. Your email submission may contain as many answers & tasks as you were able to complete during the UA Quest timeframe.

Teams are encouraged to explore the City of UA as they feel comfortable.

How do I win?

Participating teams qualify for potential prizes. Prizes will be raffled off to the eligible teams.

- (1) Your team must be registered.
- (2) Your answers must be received before the UA Quest deadline.
- (3) Raffle entries will be awarded based on the following:
 - o 1 entry for a team UA spirit wear photo
 - o 1 entry for each correct clue answer as evaluated by a Historical Society volunteer
 - o 1 entry for each correct bonus question answer as evaluated by a Historical Society volunteer
 - o 1 entry for a team photo at each correct location as evaluated by a Historical Society volunteer
 - o Additionally, the first 5 teams to submit will receive additional entries: 5 for first place; 4 for second; 3 for third; 2 for fourth; and 1 additional entry for fifth.

Prizes will be drawn in reverse-order starting with the larger prizes. Once a team has won a prize they are ineligible to receive any subsequent prizes.

What are the prizes?

When is the prize drawing?

The prize drawing will be held during the week following the end of the Quest. Winners will be notified by the Upper Arlington Historical Society and will be posted on the UA Historical Society webpage and social media. Prizes will be delivered soon after.



What else should I know?

Please remember this is a community scavenger hunt; have fun and play fair. All teams must obey all motor vehicle laws and City of UA and State of Ohio laws while participating. No speeding, stealing, trespassing, defacing, etc. will be tolerated, and those found in violation will be disqualified immediately.
